PRAWN LAKSA **22**
Malaysian-style laksa broth with prawns, noodles, Asian veg, bean sprouts & herbs (contains crustaceans)

Pappardelle with prosciutto, asparagus & snap peas tossed in a leek & spinach sauce, finished with lemon, garlic & pecorino cheese
